DEVOLA MULTI USE TRAIL, PAUL LEWIS EXPLAINED THEY RECEIVED A GRANT FROM ODNR BUT IN ORDER TO GET THE MONEY THEY HAVE TO HAVE FRONT MONEY. HIS REQUEST IS THAT MRCC LOAN UP TO \$40,000 TO BE USED FOR THIS PURPOSE. AS CONTRACTS ARE AWARDED FOR PROJECTS, THE MONEY IS PAID TO MUSKINGUM TWP. THE TOWNSHIP WOULD PAY THE CONTRCTORS FOR WORK DONE, ONCE THEY GET GRANT MONEY FROM ODNR THEY WOULD THEN RETURN THE MONEY TO MRCC. THE LENGTH OF THIS LOAN WOULD BE UP TO 15MO. GEORGE BROUGHTON HAS AGREED TO MATCH THE "FRONT MOEY" THAT MRCC PUTS UP. MEMBERS AGREED TO APPROVE SUCH A LOAN CONTINGENT ON PAPERS FROM MUSKINGUM TWP SAYING THE MONEY WOULD BE RETURNED IN A TIMELY MANNER. IT WAS ALSO NOTED THAT THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE COULD APPROVE

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS. SECOND VOTE WILL BE TAKEN AT NEXT MEETING.
